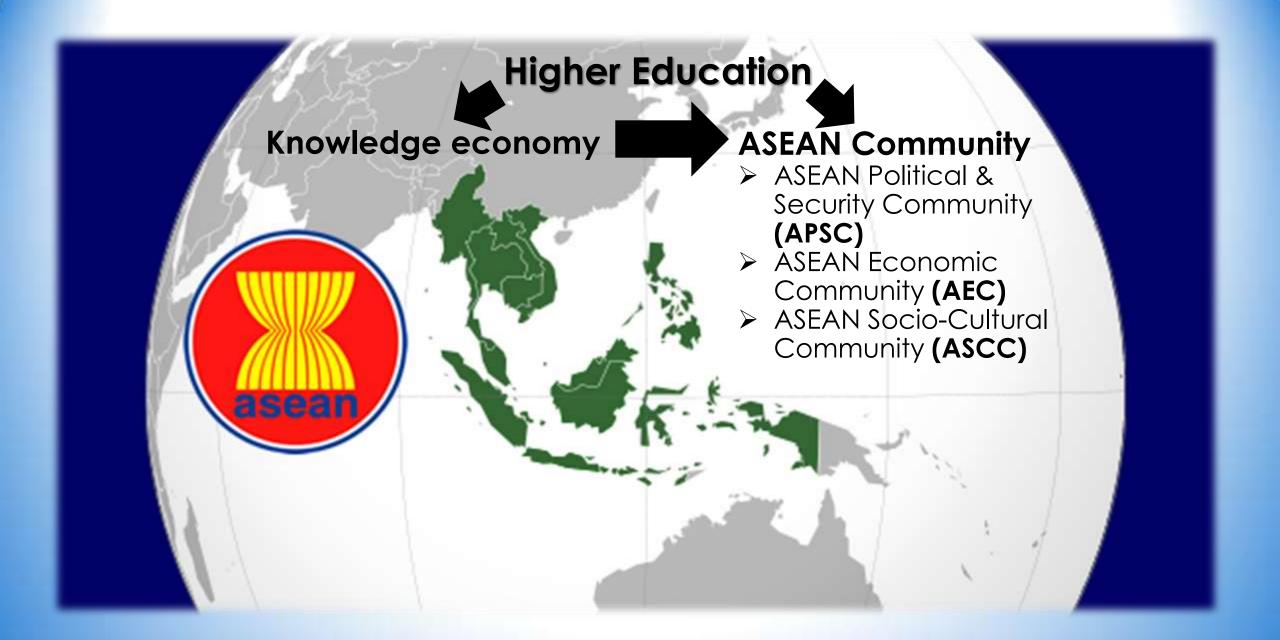

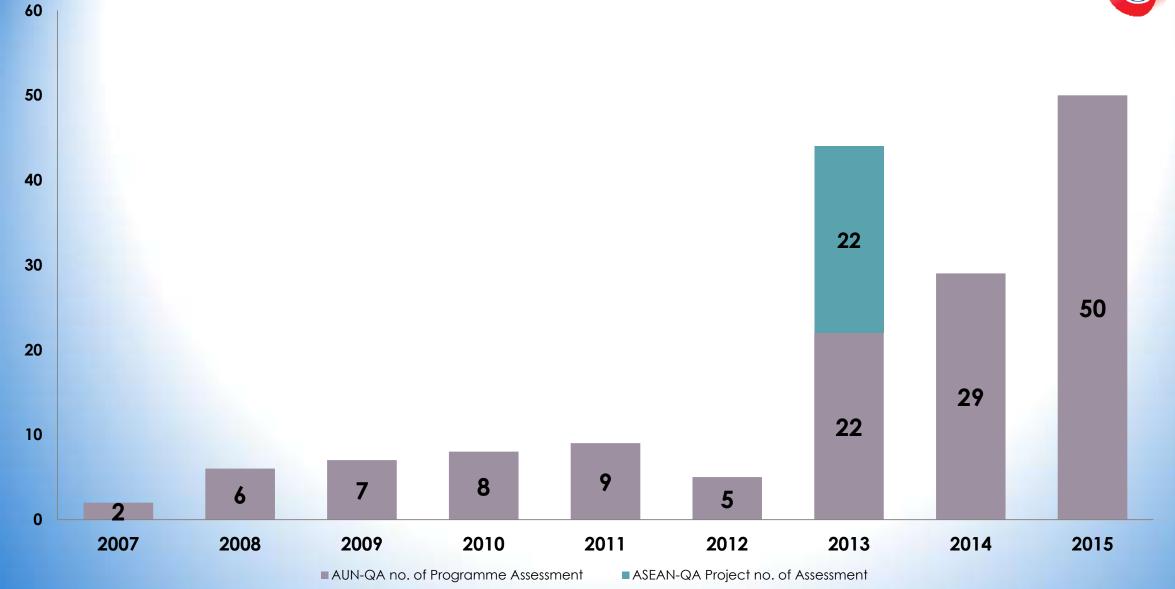

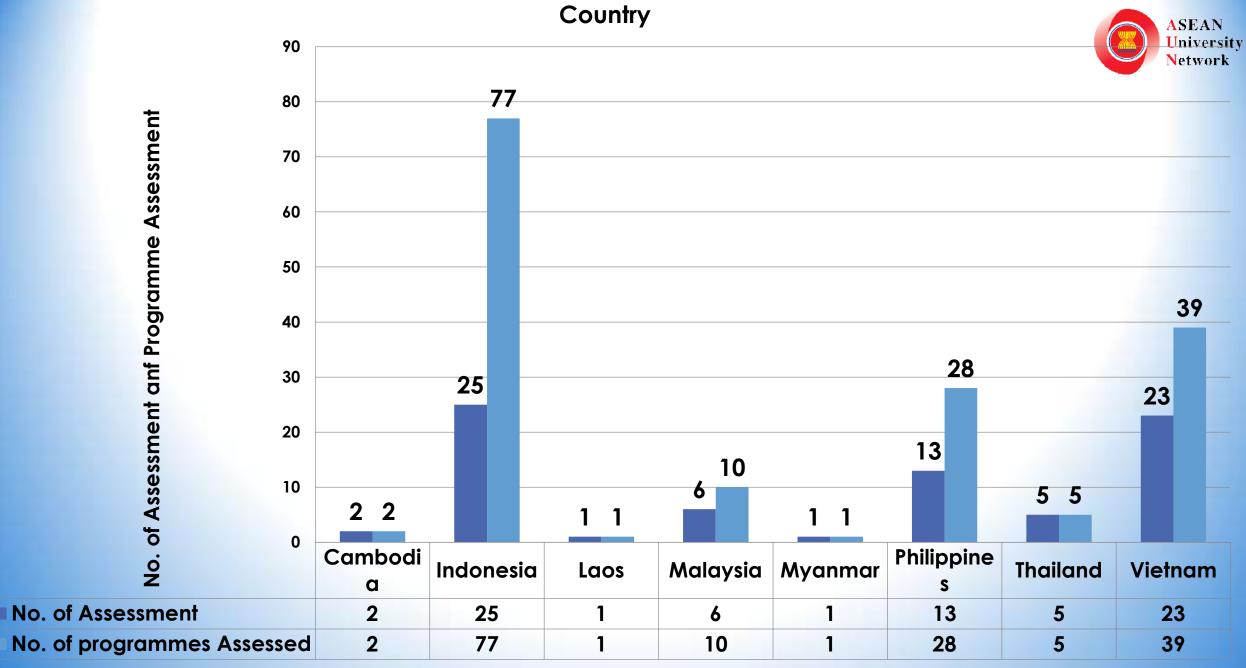




No. of programmes assessment

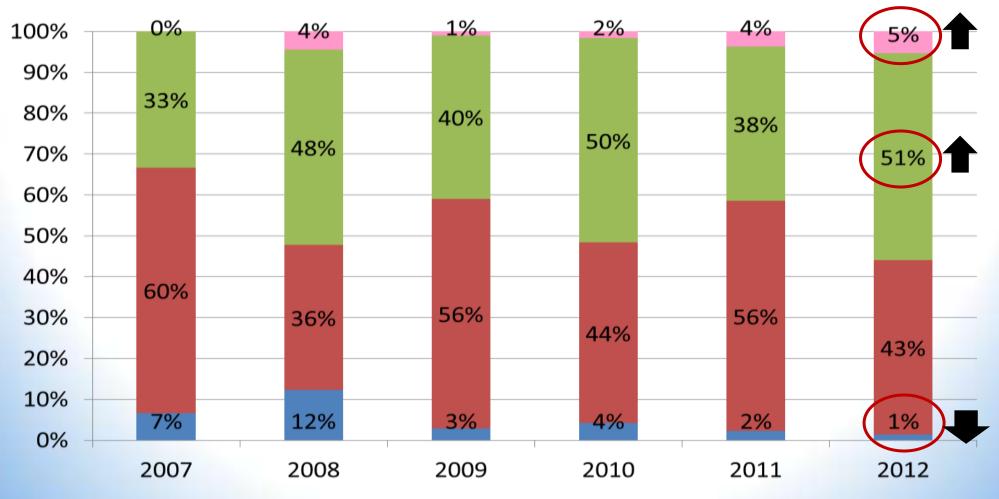








AUN-QA ASSESSMENT RESULTS (BY RATINGS)

International recognition:

- Publicity of AUN-QA system (AUN-QA Guidelines & AUN-QA Manual) have been used as the
 examples of good practices among universities in ASEAN as well as East African Universities.
- Translation of AUN-QA Guidelines and Manual to Chinese, Vietnamese, Indonesian and Thailanguages
- By being high recognition within ASEAN;
- MOET, Vietnam already established the Regional QA Centre at VNU-Hanoi and VNU-HCMC based on AUN-QA System
- MOE, Indonesia has recognized AUN-QA System to be voluntary implemented among universities
- Chulalongkorn University, Thailand also adopts AUN-QA System to be implemented internally soon.
